

**MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING**  
**May 6, 2008**

The Sunshine Meeting of Steubenville City Council was called to order at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Domenick Mucci, Jr. presiding. The meeting was opened with a silent prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Present were Councilmen Lalach, Metcalf, Perkins, Stasiulewicz, Chanoski, DiLoreto, and Fortunato.
