SUBJECT: **2014 Lovers Lane Roadway Repairs
ROAD CLOSED**

STEUBENVILLE – The City of Steubenville will resume work on the Lovers Lane Roadway Repairs starting Wednesday, May 7, 2014 continuing through Monday, May 12, 2014; weather permitting. Lovers Lane will be CLOSED to through traffic from Fort Steuben Drive to Fernwood Road during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Lovers Lane will be closed in sections to perform various patch repairs. The work zone area will be from Fernwood Road to Sinclair Avenue and from Sinclair Avenue to Fort Steuben Drive. Local access to property owners whom reside within the project sections along Lovers Lane will be maintained. However motorists should allow extra time in their travels for periodically stopped traffic.

Motorists are also advised to use caution within the work zone and to be aware of the work zone signage. All through traffic are advised to use John Scott Hwy and Sinclair Avenue as the detour.

The City has contracted with Shelly & Sands, Inc. of Rayland, Ohio to do this project and is funded using the 0.7% City Income Tax Revenue.
