SUBJECT: **2014 City Street Hot-Mix Resurfacing Improvements**

STEUBENVILLE – On Monday, November 3, 2014 at 7:00 A.M. and continuing throughout the week, weather permitting. The Contractor will begin placing the new hot-mix asphalt surface course on the project streets. Traffic will be maintained, however motorists are advised to allow extra time during travel for the periodically stopping of traffic.

Streets included in this phase of the operation will be:

<b>HARVARD AVENUE</b>	Lovers Lane	East Terminus

The Project Streets will be posted "NO PARKING" at least one day in advance. If vehicles are left on the street, vehicles will be towed and owners will be responsible for towing and storage fees. We apologize for any inconvenience.
