SUBJECT: **2015 City Street Hot-Mix and CDBG Street Resurfacing Improvements**

STEUBENVILLE – On Monday, July 6, 2015 at 7:00 A.M. and continuing throughout the week, weather permitting. The Contractor will begin placing the new hot-mix asphalt surface course on the project streets. Traffic will be maintained, however motorists are advised to allow extra time during travel for the periodically stopping of traffic.

Streets included in this phase of the operation will be:

OPAL BOULEVARD from Sunset Boulevard to Braybarton Boulevard

GLENDWELL ROAD from Opal Boulevard to South Terminus

CENTRAL AVENUE from Johnson Road to Glendwell Road

The Project Streets will be posted "NO PARKING" at least one day in advance. If vehicles are left on the street, vehicles will be towed and owners will be responsible for towing and storage fees. We apologize for any inconvenience.

The City has contracted with Shelly & Sands, Inc. of Rayland, Ohio to do this project and is funded using the 0.7% City Income Tax Revenue.
