SUBJECT: Lawson Avenue to include Pleasant Heights and Lincoln Heights

STEUBENVILLE –Monday November 18, 2019 starting at 7am and continuing until completed the water department and contractors will be replacing a section of 16 inch water main at Lawson Avenue and Orchard Street. Pleasant Heights and Lincoln Heights water service may be affected at times during this project. As of now a plan has been put in place to attempt to keep water service active for those hilltops but in the event that conditions worsen the water may be shut off for a period of time tomorrow. It is the Steubenville Water Department's goal to affect the least number of customers as possible during all projects.

Due to the complexity of this work all residents in these areas may experience water quality issues such as Loss of Water, Low Water Pressure, or Water Discoloration. If you experience any of these conditions residents are asked to report the condition to the Water Filtration Plant at 740-283-6041.

There will be lane restrictions and traffic control during this work. Motorist are cautioned to find an alternative route and use extreme caution when driving in the work zone.

We thank the residents of Steubenville for their patience and understanding throughout this very important project as we work to improve our Water System.
