

JEF-Lovers Lane / Ft. Steuben Drive Intersection Improvement
Second Open House Planned for July 24th

Steubenville – The City of Steubenville, in conjunction with the Brooke-Hancock-Jefferson Metropolitan Planning Commission (BHJ) and Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), is hosting a second public open house meeting to present the preferred design alternative for project JEF-Lovers Lane/Ft. Steuben Drive to improve the intersection of Lovers Lane and Ft. Steuben Drive.

The City has a history dating back to 1976 for improvements to Lovers Lane. The current project builds on previous alternatives concepts developed in 2008 as part of a Lovers Lane Concept Study, which included the T-intersection of Lovers Lane and Fort Steuben Drive. The project is anticipated to improve traffic operation, geometrics, and pavement condition at the intersection of Lovers Lane and Fort Steuben Drive, while considering pedestrian accommodations and sensitive residential concerns.

The project limits include Lovers Lane from just south of Teresa Drive to proximity of Preston Road, and minimal approach work on Ft. Steuben Drive as needed to accommodate the intersection improvements.

The open house is being held to present the preferred alternate of the project. Personnel from the City of Steubenville, BHJ, ODOT and GPD Group (consultant hired by the City) will be on hand to discuss the selected alternative, listen to comments, and answer questions.
