SUBJECT: Valve Replacement Project and Hydrant Replacement Project

STEUBENVILLE – The Week of March 25, 2019 there will be valve work on the City of Steubenville's Water Main Line Valves. The Crews will be **Working on Valves** and **Replacing Fire Hydrants** in the following areas: Labelle, Pleasant Heights, Lincoln Heights, South End of Steubenville and Downtown from University Blvd to Lincoln Ave. The Valves on the West End have been completed but the crews may need to enter those areas briefly.

Due to the complexity of the Valve replacement Project all residents in these areas may experience water Quality Issues such as Loss of Water, Low Pressure, and Water Discoloration. If you experience any of these conditions Residents are asked to call the Water Filtration Plant at 740-283-6041.

We thank the residents of Steubenville for their patience and understanding throughout this very important project as we work to improve our Water System.
Motorists are advised to allow extra time for their travels.
