

Utility Review Board Hearing: 04/10/2018

Account: **Richard Humienny** **1614 Penna Ave.**

Dispute: Mr. Humienny had water service turned on at this address. He called back because the meter was leaking. It was determined that the meter was burst and he was charged for the new meter. He states that when water service was turned off on August 3, 2017, he asked if the meter needed to be removed and was told we no longer removed the meters. He feels that he should not have to pay for the new meter.

Decision: The Board rescheduled this hearing until April 24, 2018 to review.

Account: **Martin Ayers** **1275 Lincoln Ave.**

Dispute: Meter Dept went to investigate whether someone was living at this address. They found that Mr. Ayers was living there. There was no meter here and they discovered that it was straight plumbed. The police were also present. An account was opened in his name and he owes \$942.76 on bill from August, 2017 to present. He says he agrees he owes about \$300.00 but states he called about water shooting out of the pipe and claims he put a straight pipe in to stop the water. He also states that he just has his belonging there and uses it as storage.

Decision: The Board decided that since the Police and meter Dept verified the straight pipe and he was stealing water, no relief will be granted. He is responsible for the bill.

Account: **Rebecca DeVore** **3223 Sunset Blvd.**

Dispute: Hearing was scheduled to dispute current bill.

Decicion: Rebecca failed to show for the hearing and did not call to cancel. The board decided that no more hearings will be held for this matter. The bill needs paid in full.
