SUBJECT: **2018 CDBG Street Resurfacing Improvements**

STEUBENVILLE – On Monday, June 18, 2018 at 7:00 AM and continuing throughout the week; weather permitting. The Contractor will begin placing the new hot-mix asphalt surface course on the project street. Traffic will be maintained, however motorists are advised to allow extra time during travel for the periodically stopping of traffic. Motorists may use alternate routes to avoid delays.

The Project Streets will be posted "NO PARKING" at least one day in advance. If vehicles are left on the street, vehicles will be towed and owners will be responsible for towing and storage fees. We apologize for any inconvenience.

Streets included in this phase of the operation will be:

N. 5 TH Street	from	Franklin Avenue	to	Mooney Avenue
Mooney Avenue	from	N. 5 TH Street	to	North Terminus
Alley Way	from	N. 6 th Street	to	Mooney Avenue
Sherman Avenue	from	Franklin Avenue	to	North Terminus
N. 6 TH Street	from	Franklin Avenue	to	University Blvd
N. 6 TH Street Spur	from	N. 6 th Street	to	West Terminus
N. 7 TH Street	from	Franklin Avenue	to	University Blvd

The City has contracted with Shelly & Sands, Inc. of Rayland, Ohio to do this project and is funded using Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
