SUBJECT: **2018 City Street Resurfacing Improvement**

STEUBENVILLE – The City of Steubenville will begin the 2018 City Street Hot-Mix Asphalt Resurfacing Program starting on Monday, July 30, 2018 at 7:00 A.M. and then continuing each day throughout the week; weather permitting. The initial work will involve the removal of the existing asphalt surface using a cold milling process and then placing an asphalt intermediate course.

Traffic will be maintained, however motorists are advised to use alternate routes to avoid delays. After preparation, a new hot-mix asphalt surface will be placed a few weeks later.

However the Alley Way from South Bend Blvd to Pittsburgh St will be CLOSED to ALL Traffic on Monday, July 30, 2018 and continuing through Wednesday, August 1, 2018.

The Project Streets will be posted "NO PARKING" at least one day in advance. If vehicles are left on the street, vehicles will be towed and owners will be responsible for towing and storage fees. We apologize for any inconvenience.

The Project Streets for this phase of the project are as follows:

Ridge Avenue	from	Pittsburgh Street	to	Bellevue Blvd
South Bend Blvd	from	Bellevue Blvd	to	Ridge Avenue
Reserve Avenue	from	South Bend Blvd	to	Ridge Avenue
Alley Way	from	Bellevue Blvd	to	South Bend Blvd
Alley Way	from	South Bend Blvd	to	Pittsburgh Street
