SUBJECT: **Downtown Business District Pavement Striping Work**

**STEUBENVILLE** – The City will start the Downtown Business District Pavement Striping Project beginning Monday, May 13, 2019 at 6:00 P.M. and continuing through-out the evening, weather permitting. The work will involve the restriping of pavement markings on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, 4<sup>th</sup> Street, 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Market Street and Adams Street. This work will continue each evening until completed.

There will also be No Parking along these streets so that the contractor can also re-paint the yellow curbing along the various streets. Traffic will be maintained, however motorists are advised to be aware of periodic lane closures and changing traffic patterns during this time. Motorists are advised to expect increased delays and drive cautiously through the work zone.

The City has contracted with Griffin Pavement Striping of Columbus, Ohio to perform this work.
