SUBJECT: **Work rescheduled - 2019 City Street Hot-Mix Asphalt Resurfacing Improvement**

STEUBENVILLE – **Work rescheduled** for Monday, August 26, 2019 at 7:00 AM and continuing through-out the week; weather permitting. Contractor will continue the 2019 City Street Resurfacing Project. Work will involve the removal of the existing asphalt surface using a cold milling process and then placing an asphalt intermediate course. The Contractor will place the new hot-mix asphalt surface course on the Project Streets soon after. Motorists are advised to allow extra time during travel for the periodically stopping and/ or detouring of traffic. Motorists should use alternate routes to avoid delays.

The Project Streets will be posted "NO PARKING" at least one day in advance. If vehicles are left on the street, vehicles will be towed and owners will be responsible for towing and storage fees. We apologize for any inconvenience.

The Project Streets are as follows:

Negley Avenue	from	Portland Blvd	to	Sunset Blvd
Devonshire Road	from	Richland Street	to	East Terminus
Opal Blvd	from	Braybarton Blvd	to	Whitehaven Blvd
