SUBJECT: Valve and Line Replacement Phase II, Braybarton Blvd

STEUBENVILLE – September 19, 2019 Contractors will begin the replacement of the main water line on Braybarton Blvd, between Shady Avenue and Terri Avenue. Braybarton Circle will start after the completion of this portion. This is part of Phase II of the Valve Replacement and Waterline Replacement project. Residents will receive an informational letter packet that describes details of the line replacement.

Due to the complexity of the Valve and Line Replacement project all residents in this area may experience water quality issues such as water loss, low water pressure, or water discoloration. If you experience any of these issues residents are asked to call the Water Filtration Plant at 740-283-6041.

The water department would like to thank the residents of Steubenville for their patience and understanding through out this project and all water issues as we work to improve our water system.

Motorist that travel the area of Braybarton Blvd are advised to use extreme caution with in the work zones. Please allow extra time for travel as delays are expected throughout the project area.
