SUBJECT: **2020 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Street Resurfacing Improvements Work to Continue – Tuesday, May 26, 2020**

STEUBENVILLE – Work to continue on the 2020 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Street Resurfacing Improvement Program starting Tuesday, May 26, 2020 at 7:00 A.M. and continue daily throughout the week, weather permitting. The initial work will involve the removal of the existing asphalt surface using a cold milling process and placing the hot mix asphalt intermediate course. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes to avoid delays.

The Project Streets will be posted "NO PARKING" at least one day in advance. If vehicles are left on the street, vehicles will be towed and owners will be responsible for towing and storage fees. We apologize for any inconvenience.

Streets included in this phase of work are the following.

Tuesday, May 26 - Milling Operation, weather permitting

ROSS PARK BLVD from Lawson Ave to Lawson Ave
LAWSON AVENUE from West Adams St to Cardinal Street

Wednesday, May 27 – Paving Intermediate Course, weather permitting

The City has contracted with Lindy Paving, Inc. of New Galilee, PA. to do this project and is funded using Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the City 0.7% Income Tax Revenue. The Project completion is June 26, 2020.
