

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing will be held by the Steubenville Planning and Zoning Commission on June 1, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in City Council Chambers, 123 South Third Street, Steubenville, Ohio. The purpose of this public hearing will be to inform citizens about the Consolidated Plan, which is intended to develop a unified and strategic vision for providing decent housing; providing a suitable living environment; and expanding economic opportunities for low and moderate income households. The Consolidated Plan is a comprehensive strategy to allocate funds to implement the following formula grant programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME), and Housing Opportunity for Persons with Aids (HOPWA). The Consolidated Plan is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for funding eligibility under the above four programs, and will be used by federal and state agencies in order to determine need in other programs. The City is only eligible for CDBG program funds.

The City of Steubenville will receive a F.Y. 2020 consolidated formula allocation of in the amount of \$621,572.00 from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The City will also receive an additional CDBG allocation in the amount of \$365,667.00 from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) (Public Law 116-136) to be used for COVID-19 response activities such as: Buildings and Improvements, Including Public Facilities; Assistance to Businesses, including Special Economic Development Assistance; and Provision of New or Quantifiably Increased Public Services. This will be the third in a series of three (3) public hearings to be held regarding the Consolidated Plan.

Citizens, representatives of community groups and non-profit organizations and public service providers are encouraged to attend the public hearing to become informed about the consolidated planning process and to express their views and comments regarding the City's needs and program activities to meet these needs. City Council Chambers is wheelchair accessible.
