ASPHALT SURFACE COURSE**

STEUBENVILLE – Work to continue on the 2020 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Street Resurfacing Improvement Program starting Monday, June 15, 2020 at 7:00 A.M. and continue daily throughout the week, weather permitting. The work will involve the placing of the hot mix asphalt surface course. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes to avoid delays.

The Project Streets will be posted "NO PARKING" at least one day in advance. If vehicles are left on the street, vehicles will be towed and owners will be responsible for towing and storage fees. We apologize for any inconvenience. Included are the following streets.

ELK STREET	from	Park Street	to	Jefferson Street
JEFFERSON ST	from	Pine Street	to	West Terminus
OAKMONT AVE	from	Jefferson St	to	Cardinal Street
ROSSWELL AVE	from	Claire Street	to	Cardinal Street
CARDINAL STREET	from	Lawson Ave	to	Summit Avenue
LAWSON AVENUE	from	West Adams St	to	Cardinal Street
ROSS PARK BLVD	from	Lawson Ave	to	Lawson Ave
