

Coronavirus Response Initiatives

In response to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the Steubenville Planning and Zoning Commission has allocated CDBG-CV funds received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to 2 activities designed to help individuals and businesses affected by the coronavirus. These activities are as follows:

Microenterprise Assistance: assistance to existing and new businesses with 5 or fewer employees (including owner(s)) to include technical assistance, training, mentoring, and coordination with Continuum of Care (CoC) services. Subsistence Payments: short-term (no more than six months) emergency payments on behalf of individuals or families, generally for the purpose of preventing homelessness. Payments will include payment of non-city utilities and rent/mortgage payments to prevent eviction.
