

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing will be held by the Steubenville Planning and Zoning Commission on March 1, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. in City Council Chambers, 123 South Third Street, Steubenville, Ohio. The purpose of this public hearing will be to inform citizens about the FY 2021 Consolidated Plan One-Year Action Plan, which is intended to develop a unified and strategic vision for providing decent housing; providing a suitable living environment; and expanding economic opportunities for low and moderate income households. The Consolidated Plan is a comprehensive strategy to allocate funds to implement the following formula grant programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME), and Housing Opportunity for Persons with Aids (HOPWA). The Consolidated Plan is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for funding eligibility under the above four programs, and will be used by federal and state agencies in order to determine need in other programs. The City is only eligible for CDBG program funds.

The Consolidated Plan is carried out through Annual Action Plans, which provide a concise summary of the actions, activities, and the specific federal and non-federal resources that will be used each year to address the priority needs and specific goals identified by the Consolidated Plan. The City of Steubenville will receive a F.Y. 2021 consolidated formula allocation, the amount of which has yet to be determined, from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. This will be the first in a series of three (3) public hearings to be held regarding the Consolidated Plan.

Citizens, representatives of community groups and non-profit organizations and public service providers are encouraged to attend the public hearing to become informed about the consolidated planning process and to express their views and comments regarding the City's needs and program activities to meet these needs.
