SUBJECT: Lawson Avenue/Orchard Street Waterline Replacement Project

STEUBENVILLE –Monday February 1, 2021 City Contractors will begin a main waterline replacement project on Lawson Avenue and Orchard Street. This work will encompass the replacement of a 16 inch water line on Lawson Avenue through Lawson Alley, sections of a 12 inch water line on Lawson Avenue from Orchard Street to Plum Street, and a 6 inch waterline on Orchard Street from Lawson Avenue to Union Avenue. Orchard Street will be closed to thru traffic from Union Avenue to Lawson Avenue for the duration of this work. Work is expected to last 5-6 weeks through the months of February and March. This work is the final step in the Phase II Valve and Waterline replacement project.

Due to the complexity of this work all residents in these areas may experience water quality issues such as Loss of Water, Low Water Pressure, or Water Discoloration. If you experience any of these conditions residents are asked to report the condition to the Water Filtration Plant at 740-283-6041.

There will be lane restrictions and traffic control during this work. Motorist are cautioned to find an alternative route and use extreme caution when driving in the work zones.

We thank the residents of Steubenville for their patience and understanding throughout this very important project as we work to improve our Water System.
