

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing will be held by the Steubenville Planning and Zoning Commission on March 1, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. in City Council Chambers, 123 South Third Street, Steubenville, Ohio. The purpose of this public hearing will be to inform citizens about the Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) grant program, including an explanation of eligible activities and program requirements. The CHIP grant program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) and is a federally funded program. The City of Steubenville is only able to apply for HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) funded eligible activities, such as housing rehabilitation, homeownership assistance, and tenant-based rental assistance. These activities are primarily designed to benefit low and moderate income persons. The City is eligible to apply for \$250,000 in CHIP grant program funds.

Citizens, representatives of community groups and non-profit organizations and public service providers are encouraged to attend the public hearing to become informed about the CHIP grant program and to express their views and comments regarding the City's needs and program activities to meet these needs. This will be the first in a series of two (2) public hearings to be held regarding the CHIP program.
