SUBJECT: **2021 Spring Clean Up Schedule**

STEUBENVILLE – The City of Steubenville Sanitation Department will conduct a Spring Clean-Up Collection for Steubenville residents with active and current utility accounts according to the schedule listed below. This collection is limited to household items only and will take place on the scheduled dates only. All items are to be placed at the curb where regular trash collection occurs each week no sooner than the night prior to the scheduled collection. Once this schedule is completed, there will be no return trips.

Friday, April 9, 2021 – All streets on Labelle View.

Friday, April 16, 2021 - All streets on Pleasant Heights.

Friday, April 23, 2021 - South End – All streets from Market Street to the South City Limit, from Spring Avenue to State Route 7 and including Lincoln Heights

North End – All streets from Alikanna to Market Street from 11th Street to State Route 7.

Friday, April 30, 2021 – All streets on North Side of Sunset Boulevard from Brady Avenue to West City Limit (Including Brady Avenue).

Friday, May 7, 2021 – All streets on South Side of Sunset Boulevard from McCauslen Manor to West City Limits.

Clean up collection services will not be provided to those who do not have an active and current utility account with the City of Steubenville, are found to be abusing the program, or place out for collection prohibited items as listed below:

RESTRICTIONS / PROHIBITED ITEMS:

- Tires of any kind.
- E-Waste (electronics) – computers, televisions, etc.
- Freon Gases – refrigerator, freezer, air conditioning unit, dehumidifier, etc.
- Hazardous Wastes / Petrochemicals – fuels, oils, solvents, paint, etc.
- Construction Material – shingles, plaster/drywall, concrete, block, brick, etc.
