SUBJECT: **2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Street Resurfacing Improvements**

STEUBENVILLE – The City of Steubenville will begin the 2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Street Resurfacing Improvement Program starting Monday, May 3, 2021 at 7:00 A.M. and continue daily throughout the week, weather permitting. The initial work will involve the replacement of deteriorated storm drainage structures within the Project Area. Traffic will be maintained, with periodic lane restrictions. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes to avoid delays. After preparation, a hot-mix asphalt intermediate course will be placed.

The Project Streets will be posted "NO PARKING" at least one day in advance. If vehicles are left on the street, vehicles will be towed and owners will be responsible for towing and storage fees. We apologize for any inconvenience.

Included in this project are the following streets.

SUMMIT AVENUE	from	Claire Street	to	Cardinal Street
CARDINAL STREET	from	Summit Avenue	to	Spring Avenue
SPRING AVENUE	from	Hill Avenue	to	South Street
SOUTH STREET	from	Spring Avenue	to	Hill Avenue
HILL AVENUE	from	South Street	to	Spring Avenue
DRESDEN AVENUE	from	North Terminus	to	850 Ft south of N. Terminus
